^{*}Wash items on hot/hot with the strongest detergent/bleach you are comfortable using. Dry immediately two or more times with the highest temperature possible, and then fold and store immediately in paper grocery bags. Staple or tightly tape bags completely closed and label with their contents. Store the bags near where you plan to birth. Your Midwife will get them out when necessary.
